Burlington School District Launches School Climate Survey: A Letter from Superintendent Yaw Obeng

Dear Burlington School District Parents and Guardians,

BSD continues to work towards building a stronger relationship with all parents/guardians, students, staff and teachers throughout our school community. As part of this work, we will be conducting a district-wide climate survey this month. This survey is a direct response to the District's Strategic Plan forums and the focus on some of the goals which came out of that process regarding Equitable Culture and Climate and Inclusive Teaching and Learning. Research proves positive school climate is recognized as an important target for school reform and improving behavioral, academic, and mental health outcomes for students (Thapa et al., 2012). Therefore, we have sought and received grant funding to work with the National School Climate Center (NSCC) to plan, administer, and analyze a district-wide survey that will provide benchmarks across several demographics (employees, parents, and students) regarding the current state of the culture and climate throughout our district.

We would like to hear from as many students, parents, and adults in our district as possible, so we are asking all parents/guardians to complete the Comprehensive School Climate Inventory (CSCI) survey. There will be different versions of the survey for students, parents/guardians, and BSD employees and we have developed an additional strategy that includes working with members of our community who do not primarily speak English or have easy access to the Internet. The survey is designed to assess perceptions of school climate, including feelings about safety, relationships, learning, the environment, and communication within the school.

The survey should take approximately 20 minutes to complete. Your feedback is imperative to helping Burlington School District understand and improve the specific climate issues in our schools and district. All responses are strictly anonymous. There are no names or other personally identifying information attached to the survey. Furthermore, results will not be broken down to sub-groups with ten or fewer respondents to protect their confidentiality.

The survey will be open for responses between <u>May 7, 2018</u>, and <u>May 27, 2018</u>. All surveys <u>must be</u> <u>completed no later than May 27, 2018</u>. Details on how to access and complete the survey will be sent out early next week and will be shared throughout BSD's various communication channels. NSCC will compile all of the results, conduct a thorough data analysis, and send us a detailed report. These findings will then <u>be analyzed</u> by District administrators, teachers, staff, students and parents. Once we have identified our strengths and weaknesses, we plan to share the findings and engage the greater community in creating action steps based on the results beginning at the start of the school 2018-2019 school year. Thank you for your help in this critical exercise.
